Accomplishments/Action Items Completed:

1. **Monitoring Update**– The External Monitoring Team discussed the tools and the process for the 2020 Monitoring process and what should be expected. Tools were approved at the Monitoring Working Group on January 8, 2020 and those tools have posted to Helphome.org. The only tool not available is the Coordinated Entry tool as the Coordinated Entry Working Group will be feeding scores for each of the providers to the Monitoring Working Group and External Monitoring Team for incorporation into the entire monitoring tool. Coordination has occurred between the External Monitoring Team, HomeBase, facilitators of the CoC competition and the Collaborative Applicant to ensure that the monitoring timeline aligned with expected timeline for the CoC Competition.
2. **Unmet Need Calculation** – The Data and Systems Improvement Working Group has been refining the unmet need calculation and has begun discussion as a group to plug in data to help determine priorities for the upcoming competition. Consideration needs to be given to how this will be presented to the community and get posted and does this need to be presented to and approved prior to distribution.
