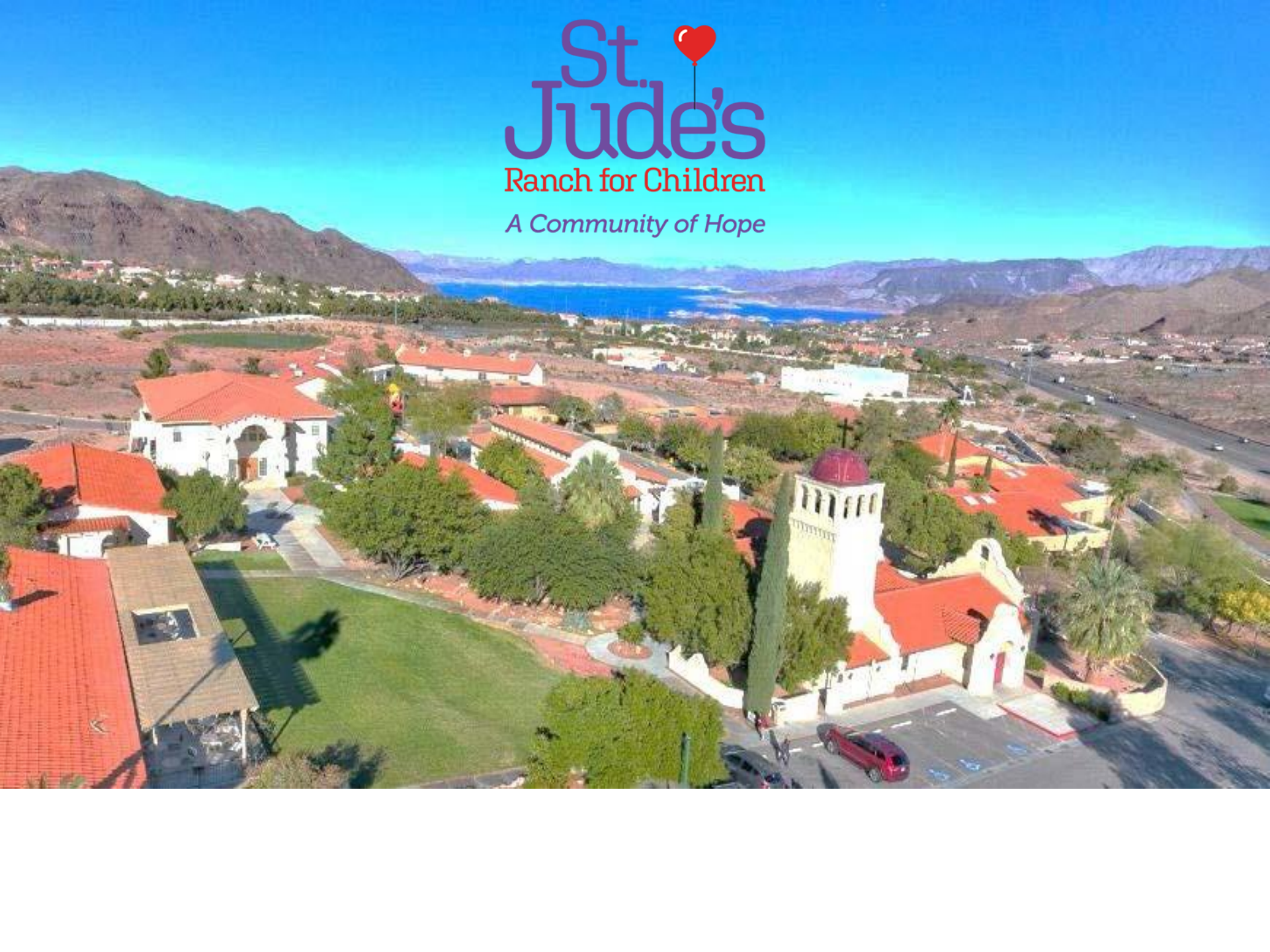

Child Sex Trafficking

- Commercial sexual exploitation of children (also known as child sex trafficking) involves the:
 - Recruitment, harboring, transportation, provision, obtaining, or advertising of a minor child for the purpose of a commercial sex act.
- Traffickers often prey upon a child's vulnerability and use psychological pressure, violence and intimidation to control the child for financial benefit relating to their sexual exploitation.
- Child sex trafficking has devastating consequences for its victims, including long-lasting physical and psychological trauma, disease, or even death.
- Children with adverse childhood experiences such as abuse and neglect, living in foster care and/or in the juvenile justice system are at heightened risk.

Nevada CSEC Coalition

Based on the 2019 Coalition Strategic Plan:

- Nevada is a major destination for child exploitation
- Nevada ranked 10th in the nation for the number of human trafficking cases reported to the National Human Trafficking Hotline in 2017
 - At least 92% of the 199 cases involved sex trafficking, and 23% of the 199 involved minors.
- FBI's Innocence Lost Initiative identified Las Vegas as one of thirteen High Intensity Child Prostitution Areas.
- In 2017, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (LVMPD) identified 126 minor sex trafficking victims, with 122 being female and 4 being male. Of the 126, 80 were reported as prior runaways, and 79 were local youth

2019 Coalition Strategic Plan

Objective 2b. Provide a holistic continuum of care for CSEC, including quality placement options with secure funding sources.

Strategy

2b.2. Facilitate the development of specialized treatment foster homes, specialized group homes and specialized residential treatment for CSEC; and the identification of secure funding.

Our Response

St. Jude's Ranch for Children is planning to create the first of its kind-Healing Center based on:

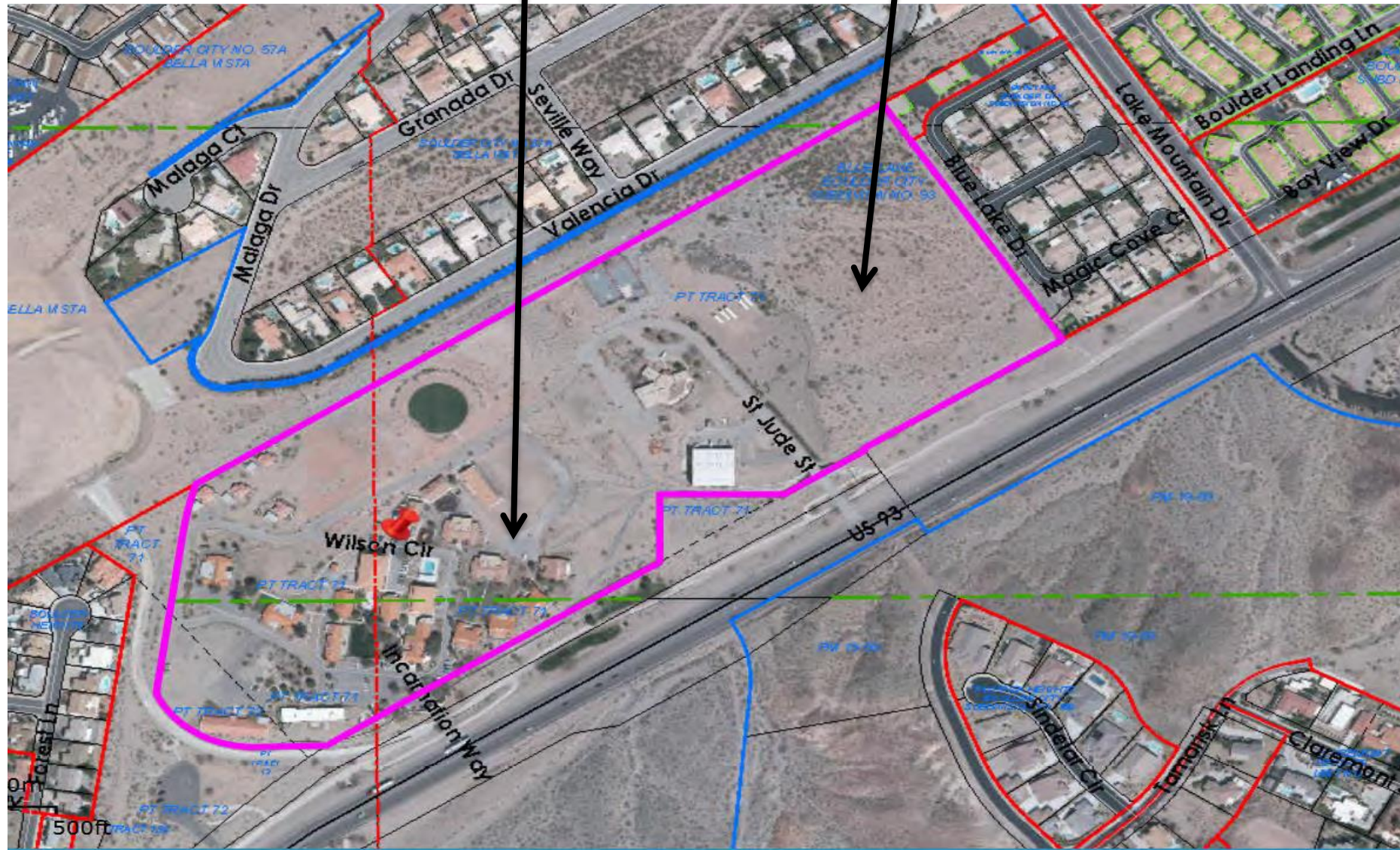
- **History**-over 50 years serving children and youth with complex trauma
- **Knowledge**-Highly experienced leadership team
- **Track Record**-Proven program outcomes
- **Resources**-Land, staffing and industry knowledge
 - Use of 11 acres of existing 38 acres of land
- **Partnership**-State and local partners to include Clark County Department of Family Services, Social Services and Juvenile Justice Services

The Healing Center will provide specialized and holistic care for child victims of sex trafficking to break the cycle of abuse and neglect and transition these young people from victim to survivor and then thriving.

Healing Center Proposal

Campus will include:

- Administration building with emergency shelter (approx. 4,110 sq. ft.)
- Multi-purpose building (approx. 6,000 sq. ft.)
 - On-site school
 - Computer lab
 - Yoga and meditation room
 - Physical fitness room
 - Courtyard
- Large residential home (approx. 4,640 sq. ft.)
- Smaller residential home (approx. 3,700 sq. ft.)
- Estimated cost \$15million dollar project



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
