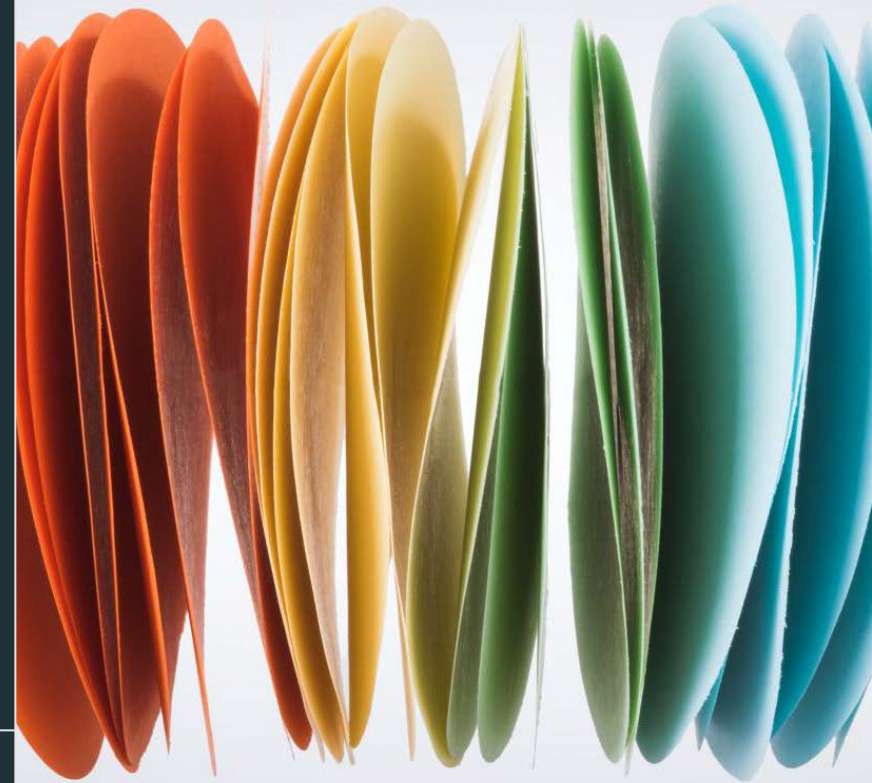


# 2022 HUD Continuum of Care Unsheltered and Rural Homelessness Consolidated Application Recommendations

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# HUD Policy Priorities

## **1. Unsheltered Homelessness**

- Significantly greater health challenges and experiences of trauma and violence; Connections to health and housing resources

## **2. Rural Areas**

# Competition Overview

1. Develop the Community Plan
2. Host a local application process
  1. Community-wide RFQ to address items in the Community Plan
  2. Threshold reviews
  3. Scoring and Ranking Process
3. Develop narrative responses
4. Submit application
5. When awarded, HUD will contract directly with applicants
  - \* Applications will be retained by the CoC/CCSS for other funding opportunities over the next 12 months

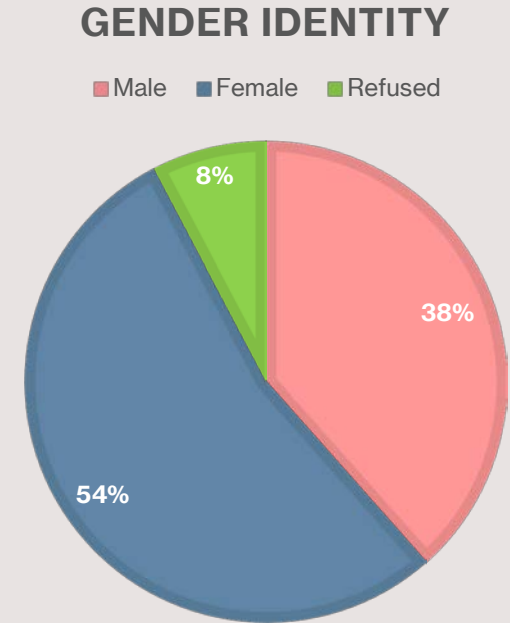
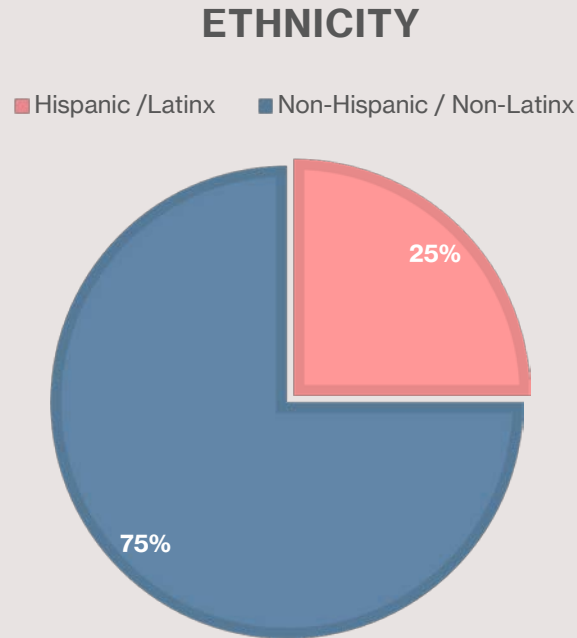
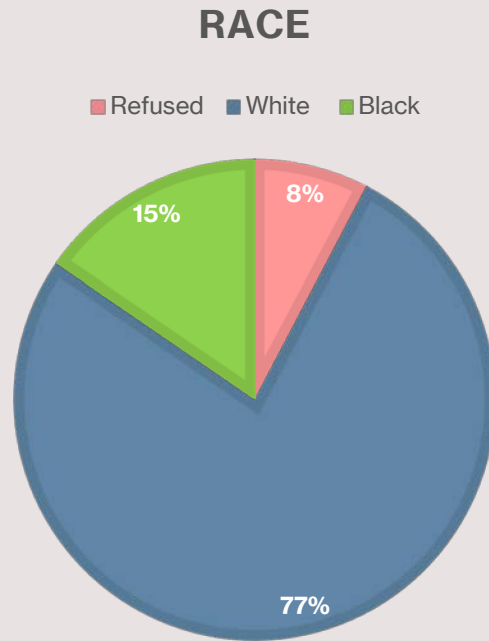

# Scoring and Ranking Team Process

- \* SRT divided into 4 smaller groups to review applications by project-type
- \* SRT reviews and scores projects individually
- \* SRT met with group to discuss applications and come to consensus with scores and recommendations
- \* SRT met publicly to discuss projects and recommendations across groups, moving projects as appropriate for inclusion in priority listing
- \* Priority listing made public, opportunity for appeals
- \* SNH CoC votes to approve priority listing
